1841 SONG (From Pippa Passes) Robert Browning Browning, Robert (1812-1899) - British Victorian Poet, noted for his dramatic monologues, his rejection of overly-florid language, and his mastery of psychological characterization. In 1846 he married Elizabeth Barrett and shared with her one of the world's most celebrated romances. Song (From Pippa Passes) (1841) - "Pippa Passes," a poetic drama, was among Browning's first significant works. This extract includes the famous lines: God's in his Heaven-/All's right with the world.

SONG

The year's at the spring And day's at the morn; Morning's at seven; The hillside's dew-pearled; The lark's on the wing; The snail's on the thorn: God's in his heaven All's right with the world!
